And when we got together back to the church everyone shared their stories and testimonies with the church. Since the beginning of the year, we have given a great importance to the gospel sharing. Before each services our folks tell their stories to whom they shared the gospel with, encouraging one another to do so. We praise God for answering to our prayers and bringing more people to the church. Some of the people who were excluded are coming back. A few who heard the gospel previously are also coming.
