The number of children varies depending on the week but there are about thirteen children coming on a regular basis. I have been working on speaking Romanian more fluently. Jennifer and I are attending bi-weekly classes. We are improving in the language. I have been afforded the opportunity to preach on Sunday evenings in Romanian. Bro. Liviu has been helping me with my translation. I write my sermons in Romanian and he helps make it sound more fluid. There are so many intricacies that make translation difficult. Certain words have a connotation to them we do not understand as second language speakers.
